

Evan Offstein Wins Frostburg State University Faculty Achievement Award

Excelerated Leadership Partners (ELP) is proud to announce that one of its co-founders, Dr. Evan Offstein, recently won the prestigious Faculty Achievement Award for Research at Frostburg State University, where he is a tenured Full Professor.

Offstein, a two-time winner of this award, earned this recognition for his impressive body of research over the last five years focusing on factors that influence the efficacy of the instructor-pupil relationship and commentary on the best mediums to deliver training and instruction. His most recent work regarding variables that influence success in executive and leadership coaching relationships won Best Paper at the 2020 Academy of Management meeting.

In the 100+ year history of Frostburg State University, Offstein is one of the few faculty members ever to win this award twice. In 2008, Offstein staked a claim to this research prize for his work on character, integrity, and honor, which resulted in his groundbreaking book, ***Stand Your Ground: Building Honorable Leaders the West Point Way***. Fifteen years after its initial publication, this book remains one of Praeger Publisher's best sellers.

Frostburg State is the largest University in the Maryland System west of Baltimore. A doctoral-granting institution with an AACSB Business School, it serves approximately 6,000 students.
